URBAN PLANNING AND ARCHITECTURE OF BUKHARA DURING THE SOVIET PERIOD

ABSTRACT

This article analyzes in detail the changes that took place in the urban planning and architecture of the city of Bukhara during the Soviet Union. During the Soviet period, Bukhara, like many cities of Uzbekistan, was under the influence of socialist constructions, and this process significantly affected the historical image of the city. Since the 1920s, the modernization of the city began in Bukhara. A number of old historical monuments, mosques and madrassas were demolished and replaced by administrative buildings, cultural centers and industrial infrastructure. During this period, the first power plant was put into operation in the city, and the population was provided with modern energy resources. Factories and factories moved to the city during the Second World War played an important role in the development of the city's infrastructure. Along with the establishment of factories and new industries, housing for workers as well as social service infrastructure were expanded. During this period, the Soviet government focused on expanding urban infrastructure, building housing estates, and new industrial areas. In Uzbekistan, many industries were established in large cities, in particular, Tashkent, Samarkand and Bukhara. This process encouraged the migration of the rural population to the cities. The Soviet-era model of urban planning focused mainly on building "socialist cities", with each city developing around various industrial enterprises. At the same time, housing and social service infrastructure was expanded. During this period, a number of projects related to the preservation and restoration of historical monuments were implemented. Bukhara was restored as a historical city, and new residences and cultural centers were established to develop tourism. In the 1960s and 1980s, new microdistricts and apartment buildings were built in the "oriental modernism" style of Soviet architecture. As part of the urban development policy carried out by the Soviet government, the historical centers of Bukhara were preserved, but the city was adapted to the requirements of the new socialist life. Historical monuments were restored for the purpose of tourism development. During this period, Bukhara rose to a new stage of not only architectural, but also socio-economic development, and the process of urbanization accelerated.
