Such activity is of great importance in the development of the child. Thus, advanced scientists and pedagogues have proven through their observation and scientific research that the game is a social event and that the surrounding existence is reflected in the game.

In the formation of every person, we can see that the organization of mental activity through games is well preserved in children's memory for their formation from early childhood. It is well known that the better and more the child is engaged in play activities, the better the development of mental activity.
