Therefore, the results of the analysis of the supply of highly qualified personnel for the social sphere and the economy, first of all, to pay more attention to the quality of training for education, the widespread introduction of advanced foreign experience in the field, pedagogical training. shows the need to improve the infrastructure.

In accordance with the Concept of development of the higher education system of the Republic of Uzbekistan until 2030, approved by the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated October 8, 2019 PF5847, development of public-private partnership in higher education, state and non-state higher education institutions in the regions In particular, it is planned to ensure that the level of higher education coverage will exceed 50% through the organization of branches of prestigious foreign higher education institutions. A number of decrees and resolutions have been adopted aimed at the introduction of medium-term targeted programs for the implementation of changes, modernization of the industry, technical and technological re-equipment and diversification, integrated socio-economic development of the regions. Today, in the era of development of high technologies and information processes in the world, the competition between companies for the training of highly qualified specialists has increased. This applies not only to commercial organizations, but also to research centers and educational institutions. Indeed, the issue of the quality of modern education is one of the most pressing issues. After all, the existing higher education institutions in our country in the future will form the knowledge of specialists in a specific professional field. - Taking into account the interests of enterprises and organizations in the creation and implementation of innovations in educational institutions;
- Assessment of the state and level of organization of the educational process in the activities of higher education institutions;
- Encouraging the work of teachers in educational institutions and a fair assessment of the psychological situation associated with the educational process;
- One of the urgent problems is to identify the reserves of pedagogical staff in the field, to develop measures for their more complete and effective use.

Thus, a new education system aimed at entering the world educational space is being established in our country. Simultaneously with this process, significant changes are taking place in the theory and practice of the pedagogical educational process. The structure of approaches to education is changing and different attitudes, pedagogical mentalities are being established. The education system is enriched by the ability to work with new information, the creative solution of which is focused on the individualization of the educational program.



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
