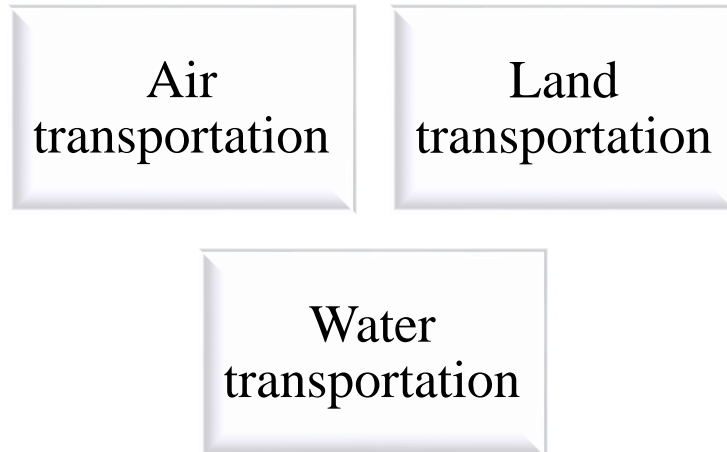

There is transport support in the system of tourism:

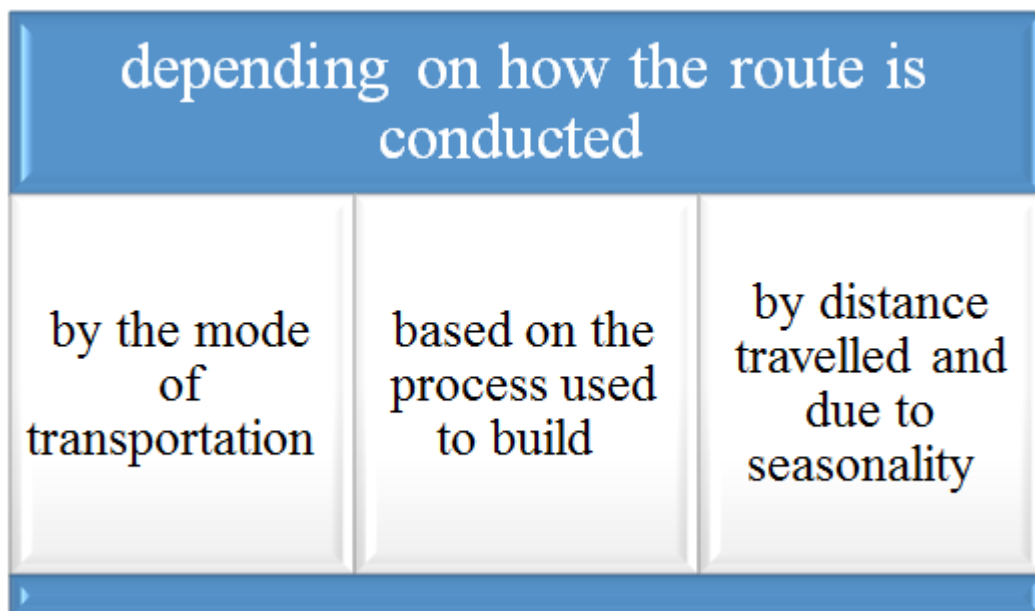
